The Grammar Police! (Y4 - Y6 / Ages 8 - 10 yrs) : Ms Ashleigh Britton

Children will study the intricacies of the English language with the main focus being spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG). They will broaden their vocabulary, discuss metaphorical language and advance their knowledge of higher level punctuation. From determiners to parentheses, homophones and plural endings, children will learn how to perfect their spoken and written English skills.
